Galleri Charlotte Lund is pleased to present a solo exhibition of new work by Anne Thulin. This will be the artist's third exhibition at the gallery.

Anne Thulin has long used the body as the starting point in her work, from making impressions of different body parts such as elbows and knees to focusing an entire exhibition on the head. She most recently showed her work at the "Ludo Alludo" exhibition at Lund Konsthall in October 2003 where viewers entered a gymnasium filled with bars, ropes, vaulting horses and wall bars. What united the pieces was that they were all dysfunctional.

This new exhibition features blown-up, swollen sculptures. Their forms have expanded and become abstract. They convey both fragility and strength.

A book covering all of Thulin's work was published in conjunction with her exhibition at the Lund Konsthall. Thulin was born in 1953 and lives and works in Stockholm and New York.
