JENNY GRANLUND

“En ko på isen”

October 6 – November 12, 2011

Galleri Charlotte Lund is pleased to present our second solo exhibition with Jenny Granlund.

The exhibition entitled “En ko på isen” (meaning appr There is no immediate danger) displays large size graphite pencil drawings on paper. Granlund draws layer upon layer using pencils of varying softness which is how she creates different shades of gray and structure in the material. Parts that get erased are always re-drawn.

Granlund’s landscape of patterns both get along and compete over the surface and create an intriguing weave of ornaments and symbols. The artists choice of patterns and ornaments are a melting-pot of doodles as well as carefully chosen symbols.

It is not by chance that the exhibition is entitled “En ko på isen”, the titles are distinguishing for the artist. They are often expressive idiom and therefor culture specific as well as hard to translate.

Jenny Granlund (b. 1972) graduated from the Royal Institute of Art in Stockholm and now lives and works in Trollhättan. The artist have had solo exhibitions at Botkyrka konsthall, Konstnärshuset in Stockholm and at Gävle konstcentrum. Earlier this year Granlund participated in a group exhibition at Södertälje konsthall. The artist is represented in the collections of Uppsala konstmuseum and the National Public Art Coucil Sweden.

During the exhibition the gallery will organise an artist talk with Jenny Granlund and an invited guest.
