Galleri Charlotte Lund has the great pleasure of presenting its sixth solo exhibition with Leif Palmquist.

Right from the start, Leif Palmquist has painted in watercolour on paper - abstract shapes and patterns with references to cosmos or conjuring sound and light. A work by the artist has often comprised of several parts.

In this exhibition, *i övergång resonans*, Leif Palmquist is showing a select few watercolours on paper, where he has palpably increased the scale of his works. They are painted with rainwater from the different locations where they have been made. Sombre colours shift from light to darkness, and the paintings have been created like pictures in processes of transition or transitions in nature. According to the artist:

*as the light of dusk transitions to darkness*  
*as the life processes of the seasons*  
*as the transition from atmospheric vapour to crystalline ice*  
*as the transition from sound to a vacuous silence*

Leif Palmquist (b. 1961) resides and works in Stockholm. He attended Forum Art School in Malmö 1986 - 91. Palmquist has had solo exhibitions at Karlskrona Art Hall, The Swedish Embassy in Tokyo and at Ronneby Culture Centre. The artist has also made site-specific works for Karolinska University Hospital in Huddinge (2015) and Viktor Rydberg School in Stockholm (2016). Palmquist's last exhibition was in the spring of 2017 at Tyresö Art Hall.
