Galleri Charlotte Lund is pleased to present our fourth solo exhibition with Marco Cueva.

In the exhibition entitled “Mythologies” are 20 sculptures on display, made in classical materials such as marble, alabaster, bronze and different exotic type of wood. For the first time the artist has used nails as ornament, these are hammered into some of the works, inspired by old african tradition.

Cueva’s work is both time-consuming and labor intensive as he physically takes on the raw and untamed materials. The body of work refers to art history as well as popular culture as the works are entitled Minotaur, Holofernes and Medusa.

Marco Cueva (b. 1965, Honduras) graduated from the Royal Institute of Art in Stockholm, and now lives and works in Stockholm. During the last ten-year period the artist has been living in Honduras, Nicaragua and Mozambique. He has made public art at Farsta Gymnasium and in Hagalund Centrum in the Stockholm area as well as at the county court in Stockholm.

During the exhibition the gallery will organise an artist talk with Marco Cueva and an invited guest.
